

Construction Management in Spain

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Participants will attend guest lectures from executives of large global construction companies on Estimating, Scheduling, Logistics and Global Operations. The program includes visits to active construction sites where students will have the opportunity to see construction methods outside the US. The program also includes visits to iconic Infrastructure facilities including the High Speed AVE train between Madrid Barcelona

LOCATION DESCRIPTION

The program includes visits to Madrid, Barcelona, and Valencia. Each of these first class cities has a wide variety of cultural and technological marvels to visit. Students will travel by plane, train and bus having a firsthand experience to mingle with people from different cultures. Madrid Metro is one of the world's 10 longest, with 293 km. The first line of the metro opened in 1919, extending 3.5 km and featuring eight stations. Today, the system in Spain's capital encompasses 300 stations on 13 lines, of which about 90 percent of the track is underground.

HOUSING

Students will share double-occupancy accommodations within local hotels. All hotel rooms are air-conditioned, and some hotels feature complimentary breakfast. A wide variety of restaurants, museums, theatres, and shopping opportunities will be available at each of the cities visited.
