YOUR DAY-TO-DAY:

- Aid in layout of building structure, partitions and other portions of the work.
- Contribute to management of tasks in accordance with company & contract guidelines.
- As required, maintain daily logs to document all jobsite activities and events.
- Assist in submittal and shop drawing review as assigned.
- Learn to coordinate many different activities.
- Use technology (hard & software) to accomplish tasks.
- Maintain a working relationship with entire project delivery team.
- Communicate with project team members to allow for maximum efficiency.
- Help implement & maintain quality control programs & life safety checkout procedures.
- Review tasks completed by you as well as by those you lead, and review for inefficiencies.
- Assist Superintendent and Project Manager with various assigned tasks.
- Lead all assigned field personnel for effective accomplishment of designated tasks.
- As required, lead field operations of trade partners to successfully complete work.
- Participate in learning activities to develop your skills.
- Teach others to complete their tasks effectively.

- This position is **Exempt** and **is not** subject to overtime pay.
- This position reports to a jobsite location.
- Travel/relocation is required.
- This position reports direct to the Superintendent.

WHAT YOU BRING TO THE TEAM:

- Preferably, a degree in Building Science, Construction Management or Civil Engineering, OR a combination of experience and other relevant degree.
- Having co-op/intern experience is a plus and healthcare construction experience is preferred.
- Good written and oral communications.
- Ability to read, analyze, & interpret safety rules, operating & maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals.

- Ability to write routine reports & correspondence.
- Ability to speak effectively before groups of trade partners & project team members.
- Advanced analytical & reading skills
- Must have computer skills in Microsoft Office Programs.
- Ability to calculate figures & amounts such as discounts, interest, commissions, proportions, percentages, area, circumference & volume.
- Ability to apply concepts of basic algebra & geometry.
- Use of basic reasoning and ability to resolve issues quickly with little or no direction.
- Ability to interpret a variety of instructions in written, oral, diagram, or schedule format.
- OSHA 10 Hour certification required. If not current, required to receive within the first year of employment and keep current.
- Basic understanding of blueprint reading.
- Basic knowledge of mechanical/plumbing and electrical systems.
- Familiar with building layout.
- Ability to recognize quality work.
- Knowledge of industry safety procedures and AHCA regulations.
- Able to frequently stand; walk; use hands to handle/feel objects, tools, or controls; reach with hands & arms.
- Able to occasionally climb or balance & stoop or kneel.
- Able to regularly lift/move up to 25 lbs. and occasionally lift/move up to 50 lbs.
- Distance and peripheral vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus.
- Ability to regularly work in outside weather conditions, frequently near moving mechanical parts and occasionally work in high, precarious places and handle exposure to wet/humid conditions.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS & WORK ENVIRONMENT:

- Regularly works in outside weather conditions. Frequently works near moving mechanical parts. Occasionally works in high, precarious places and occasionally exposed to wet/humid conditions.
- The noise level is usually moderate to high.
- Regularly required to stand; walk; use hands to handle objects, tools, or controls; and reach with hands and arms. Required to climb or balance and stoop and kneel.
- Regularly lift/move up to 25 pounds, frequently lift/move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required include distance vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus.
